Salvador Dalí and Miguel Mateu, businessman, sponsor of culture and founder of the Perelada winery, held a close friendship throughout their lives. The universal Catalan painter was a regular guest at the castle that his friend had bought in 1923. He painted and made some speeches there.

Perelada and the Gala-Salvador Dalí Foundation wants to pay tribute to Dalí with this Torre Galatea Reserva. A wine that summarizes the Empordà essence, a reflection of its soils and its climate. An environment where the artist lived for most of his life and which was an inspiration for many of his master works.

Part of the benefits obtained from the sale of this wine go to the Gala-Salvador Dalí Foundation.

Designation of Origin: Empordà.

Varietals: Syrah (41%), Cabernet Sauvignon (31%), Monastrell (14%), Samsó (11%), Merlot (3%).

Winemaking:

Harvest: Grapes selected from our five vineyards.

Winemaking: Red winemaking method, long maceration, controlled fermentation at 24°C.

Ageing: 16 months in Bordeaux barrels, 50% fine American oak and 50% Allier French oak. Then bottled.

Type of bottle: *Bordeaux*, Ancienne, 75 cl.

Tasting note:

Deep cherry red colour. Its aroma reminds of ripe fruits, spices, with some balsamic notes and a toasted background. In the mouth it is wide, well-structured and balanced. Its tannins are present but well integrated. It has a very fresh acidity. This is a wine with a great personality and a long after-taste.

Analysis:

Graduation: 14.70% by Vol.

Free SO₂: 19 mg/l.

Total SO₂: 60 mg/l.

Total acidity: 3.50 g/l (s.a.).

Volatile acidity: 0.65 g/l (a.a.).

Residual sugar: 0.20 g/l.
